

POST EXCHANGE

The Post Exchange in the BEQ is open from 0900 to 1700 Monday through Friday and carries such items as select clothing, stereos, tapes, records, watches, magazines, snacks, soft drinks, and various health and cleaning aids.

The exchange also offers a film processing service which produces good quality work at discount prices.

During Parade Season in the summer months, the exchange stays open an hour later on Friday nights.



The new BEQ was completed in 1975, and houses both male and female Marines, the Dining Facility, company offices for "A" Company and "B" Company, and other facilities, including the Enlisted and SNCO Clubs.



#### SPECIAL SERVICES

The Special Services Office provides information on all Barracks athletic programs, tickets and reservation information to local dinner theaters, professional and amateur sports events, and many others.

A complete selection of athletic equipment is available for checkout, along with camping equipment and other items.

You should check with Special Services for the gymnasium hours and regulations upon reporting in.


## Quarters Services

#### DINING FACILITY

The Barracks Dining Facility serves meals three times a day during the week, and twice during the weekend and holidays. The hours are listed below.

Monday through Friday, the facility is open from 0600-0715 for breakfast; 1100-1245 for lunch; and 1600-1730 for dinner.

During the weekend and holidays, brunch is served from 0900-1100, and dinner from 1630-1730.



#### BARRACK'S CLUBS

Both the Enlisted and SNCO Clubs are located in the BEQ, and the Officer's Club is aboard post in the Center House.

The Enlisted Club hours are from 1600-2400 on weekdays, and 1600-0100 on weekends.

The Staff NCO Club hours are from 1600-2400 on weekdays, and are set by the Staff NCO's for the weekend. Barracks' Officers also set the hours for the Officer's Club.



PRESS SHOP

The Barracks' Press Shops will press your military clothing free of charge from 0700-1600 Monday through Friday.

One press shop is located in the BEQ and another is aboard post.

All articles of clothing must be properly marked with the Marine's name before they are accepted for pressing.

The press shops do not clean the clothing, but cleaners are located aboard post and directly across from the main gate.
